plock -- lock process in memory

SYNOPSIS

(plock = 79.)
(lock flag in r0)

DESCRIPTION

Plock locks the current process in memory if the value of *flag* is non-zero and unlocks the current process if *flag* is zero. When a process is locked in memory, all segments belonging to the process are marked as non-swappable. These segments may be shifted in memory but will not be written back to secondary storage.

DIAGNOSTICS

The error bit (c-bit) is set if less than 8K words of memory are available for swapping after locking all of a process's segments in memory. From C, a -1 value is returned on an error.
